RI1FJZ Franz Josef Island -update September 2 by Vasily RA1ZZ

All border permits received — **RI1FJZ** is ready to sail!

Every member of the team has received their pass from the Border Service. Franz Josef Land is a restricted border zone and a protected nature area, and no vessel sails there without these documents. The paperwork — the most nerve-wracking and least predictable part of any Arctic project — is finally behind us.

The equipment is packed, the antennas are stowed, the crew is assembled and the permits are in hand. Apostol Andrey is ready to depart.

Ahead lies the Barents Sea, the passage north, and the northernmost DXCC entity on the air.



VK9XY Christmas Island 2026 update

The Pacific Islands DXpedition Group (PIDXG), in partnership with Youth on the Air (YOTA), is pleased to announce plans to provide remote operating opportunities to approximately forty young amateur radio operators around the world during the upcoming **VK9XY** DXpedition to Christmas Island.

VK9XY will operate from November 16 through December 4, 2026. As part of the operation, we will deploy two NexGen RiB2 remote radio systems, to be located approximately six hundred meters west of our primary operating site. Remote access to the RiB2s will be provided through a new cloud-based system called DXter. DXter supports CW, SSB, and digital modes and is accessed directly through a standard web browser, with no additional software or applications required.

XR0Z Alexander Selkirk Island SA-101 -update by Felipe and Moises

Earlier this week, we held a Zoom meeting with the Alexander Selkirk park ranger and representatives of the island's fishermen. The purpose of the meeting was to continue planning the logistics required to transport our expedition equipment from Robinson Crusoe Island (IOTA SA-005) to Alexander Selkirk Island (IOTA SA-101). Moving all of our equipment to Selkirk will be one of the major logistical challenges of this expedition, given the island's remote location and difficult terrain.

A second shipment of expedition cargo has now been sent to the port of Valparaíso. This first shipment includes non-perishable food supplies, together with part of the camping equipment we will need during our 10–12 day stay at the shelter.

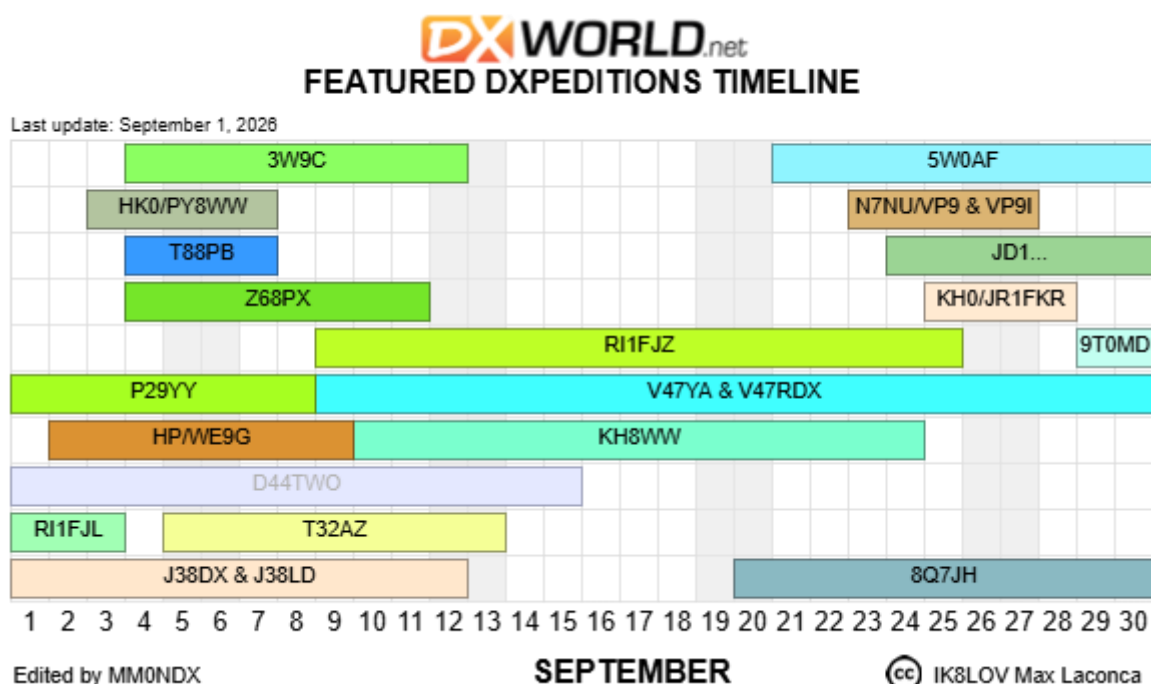

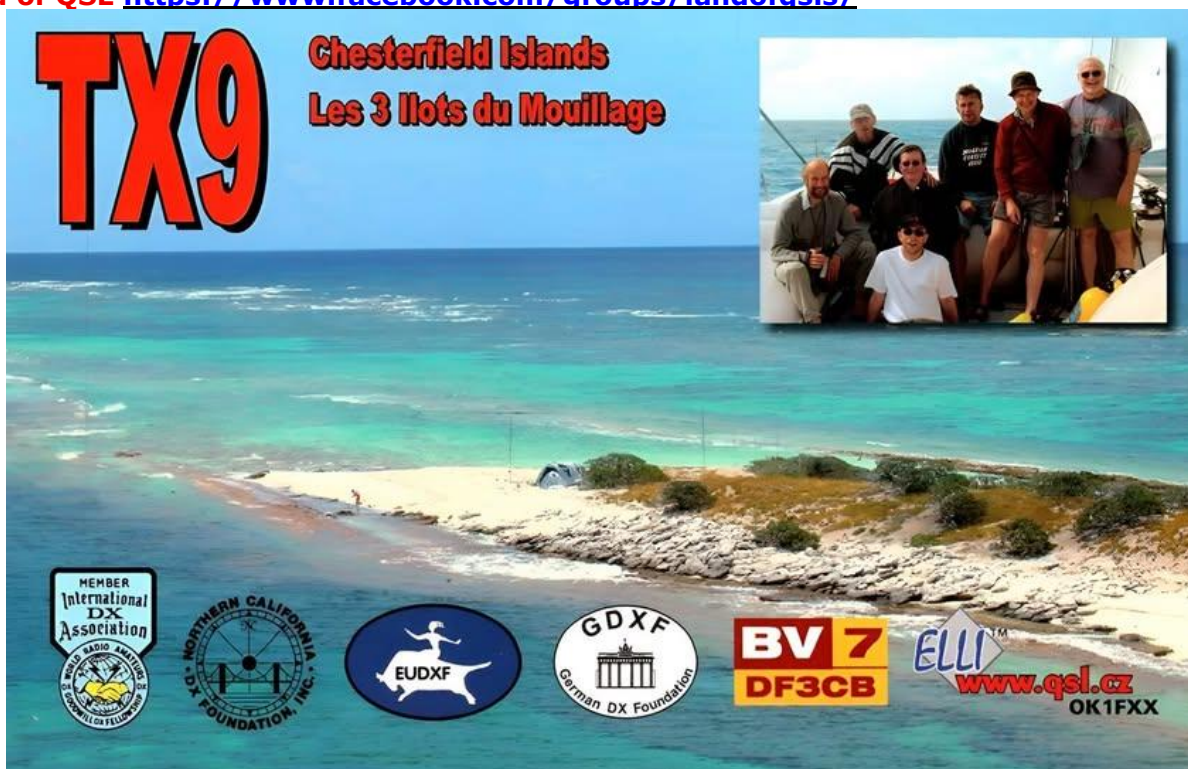
