5W0AF Samoa -update by Jacek SP5EAQ

Unfortunately, the power amplifier (PA) failure on the second day of the 5W0AF DXpedition turned out to be serious. It wasn't the power stage itself that was damaged, but the control circuitry — a fault impossible to fix under field conditions. I am currently operating with 100 watts only and will likely have to give up on the 80-meter band. I am trying to get in touch with Atsu (5W1SA) to see if he might have a spare amplifier. It would be much easier if I had his local phone number or address.

I have been operating from here during about 10 visits usually lasting 2-3 months. Pictures were taken today early morning around 20.00 UT (7.00am local). Weather has been so far poor, hardly any 24 hours without rain, sometimes cat and dogs, sometimes short light showers. Always above 25 degrees, but few sunshine.



San Ambrosio Project CE0/X -update by Felipe XQ7IR

Three important documents and/or authorizations are required to operate from San Ambrosio (CE0X). Two of these authorizations are already in my possession, and I estimate that the remaining document will be issued within the coming months.

The amateur radio license will be requested from SUBTEL (the Chilean telecommunications authority) a couple of weeks before the expedition begins, once all required permits and authorizations have been granted.

For this reason, I kindly ask everyone to refer to this operation as the "San Ambrosio Project" until the official license and assigned callsign will be granted by Subtel.

The relevant authorizations and permits will be published on this website for public information prior to the start of the activity.

RI1FJZ Franz Josef Land -update

A fresh report has arrived from the archipelago. Communication with the mainland is sparse and the message came through in transliteration, but the key point is clear: everyone is alive and well, the camp is set up, and living conditions are quite comfortable.

Power. The expedition is effectively running off-grid — on batteries and solar panels. No generators running flat out: every watt counts, and the team is getting the most out of each one.

On the air. Activity is under way on all bands. There are six HF operating positions: two CW, one SSB and three FT8. Yesterday a second 5-band Spider antenna went up, so signals from the island will be even stronger.

Satellites. For two days now the team has been working low-orbit (LEO) satellites, and this activity will only grow — right up to 23 September.

A special achievement is QO-100. Today stable reception was established, at a level of -75 dB. That's genuinely hard: at Franz Josef Land's latitude the geostationary satellite hangs right at the horizon, practically at the limit of visibility. Tomorrow the team will install the transmitting side — stay tuned!

Neighbours. There are 14 polar bear dens around the camp, and the team can see the bears with their own eyes. That's why outdoor work is limited to about five hours a day: antennas, repairs, trips to the shore — all strictly in daylight and under constant watch.
